

Schools with grade six, nine, and twelve students shall have in place a procedure for recognizing student citizenship.

1. Criteria:
 - 1.1 Demonstrated concern for school, community and people through active involvement in local or regional structures (e.g. Student's Union, 4-H, School or Community Committees, etc.).
 - 1.2 Active history of volunteerism.
 - 1.3 Proven ability to learn from errors and to positively accept consequences for actions.
 - 1.4 Proven history of actively and positively seeking solutions to problems and issues.
 - 1.5 Maintain an overall academic standard of at least 70% in the four core (Language Arts, Social Studies, Sciences and Math) academic courses.

2. Application:
 - 2.1 Grade six (6) and nine (9) - School Based Decision, nominated by staff.
 - 2.2 Grade twelve (12) - Written applications with supporting documentation need to be submitted to the School Principal. The School Principal, in turn, would follow established school timelines and procedures for the awarding of scholarships and awards. The decision of the School Principal is final.

3. Awards:
 - 3.1 \$1,000.00 will be awarded to one graduate from each of our four (4) High Schools (Swan Hills, Barrhead Composite, R.F. Staples and Vista Virtual).
 - 3.2 Two grade nine (9) students from each of the following schools will be awarded a graphic calculator: Barrhead Composite, R. F. Staples, and Vista Virtual. One graphic calculator will be awarded to a grade nine (9) student in each of the other Junior High Schools with the exception of the Hutterite Schools.
 - 3.3 Two grade six (6) students from each of the following schools will be awarded a globe of the world: Barrhead Elementary, Vista Virtual, and Westlock Elementary. One globe of the world will be awarded to a grade six (6) student in each of the other Elementary Schools with the exception of the Hutterite Schools.
 - 3.4 One scientific calculator will be awarded to a grade six (6) student in each of the Hutterite Schools. One gift certificate to purchase a tree of choice will be awarded to a grade nine (9) student in each of the Hutterite Schools.
