



Student Creative Work - Copyright Release

According section 27 (1) of the Copyright Act cited below, we are required to obtain written permission in order to share a student's original creative work with the public.

Copyright Act – Government of Canada 27. (1) *It is an infringement of copyright for any person to do, without the consent of the owner of the copyright, anything that by this Act only the owner of the copyright has the right to do.*

Students' original creative work may be used only for non-profit educational purposes. This may include displays within the community, in-service sessions, other school related activities at sites within the school division, or in school publications. Examples of original creative work include:

- a painting or drawing.
- a creative written work (poem, story, book, etc).
- an original audio or video recording (movie production).
