

Alternate Transportation – Students Served by Regular Bus Route

AP 70-123

1. Administration will not contract for private transportation or room and board unless a transfer of that student has been authorized by the Superintendent of Schools.
2. Those parents who have chosen to transfer their children to a different school must arrange for private transportation to the nearest bus route or to the school directly. If space is available on a transfer bus, and parents buy a bus pass, system transportation can be used. See AP 50-01 Requesting a School other than Designated School for more information.
3. Alternate Transportation - Private Vehicle Mileage Payments
 - 3.1 In certain situations it may be advantageous for Administration to contract with parents for the provision of transportation services.
 - 3.2 When Administration contracts with parents for the provision of transportation services, it will be for the shortest distance between the student's residence and the designated school or the nearest bus route, whichever is closer.
 - 3.3 Mileage shall be paid for two return trips per day at the Board approved travel rate as specified under Transportation Fees Rates Annex 4.
 - 3.4 When two or more families are transported together, Administration reserves the right to contract with one party to provide the service at the Board approved travel rate as specified under Transportation Fees Rates Annex 4.
