





Here's what to do when you reach the end of a quiz.

First, be sure you are ready to submit. The question numbers in the navigation tool will have a grey colour  when questions are complete. If you need to double-check a question, click on it, or use the  button.


To finalize your quiz, click the  button. Be careful! Once you confirm **Submit all and finish**, you can't go back and change your answers.

When quizzes offer feedback, it will be colour-coded; pink means an incorrect, so be sure to carefully read the feedback in the yellow area under the question.
